COLLABORATION AGREEMENT FOR THE EXECUTION OF DEVELOPMENT
PROJECTS

BY AND BETWEEN

SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE FOR SCHEDULE TRIBE AND RURAL YOUTH located in: Sistry Foundation Prangopal Nagar, Post+Ps Nabadwip, Dist:- Nadia. Pin- 741302, India/ West Bengal herein referred to as "Local Partner", represented by Mr. Tarun Kumar Ray, Legal Representative of the "Local Partner" .

And MANOS UNIDAS, with registered office located in C/ Barquillo nº 38 – 3º, 28004 Madrid (Spain), with Spanish Tax ID (CIF) number G-28567790, represented by Ms. Cecilia Pilar Gracia, in her capacity as President et Legal Representative.

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS

One.- Having taken into account the statutory objectives, or equivalent, of both Parties and in fulfilment of their respective corporate purposes, both parties agree to enter into a specific Collaboration Agreement to carry out Project number IND 78784 (0) entitled: FOOD SECURITY OF 300 WOMEN IN PURBA BARDHAMAN DIST.

Two.-MANOS UNIDAS hereby commits to providing funds in favour of the Local Partner, amounting to a total of 48.134,00 EUR.

Said funding shall be made payable according to the following itemisation of payments:

single 48.134,00 EUR

1. The first payment, which can also be constituted as a single payment, should be made upon receipt by MANOS UNIDAS of this Collaboration Agreement signed by the LOCAL PARTNER.

2. Where appropriate, second and/or each of consecutive payments should be done after acceptance by Manos Unidas of the mandatory "Follow-up Reports" and the financial justification of payments to be submitted by the LOCAL PARTNER as per MANOS UNIDAS prescribed procedure.

3. The above-mentioned payment scheme is shown in the following diagram:

PAYMENT	REQUIREMENT
FIRST PAYMENT	Receipt of duly signed Agreement
SECOND PAYMENT	Acceptance of the "Follow-up Report" and justification of at least 80% of the 1st payment
THIRD OR CONSECUTIVE PAYMENTS	Acceptance of the "Follow-up Report" and justification of 100% of 1st payment and 80% of 2 nd or immediately preceding payment

This sequence will always be the same for a larger number of installments, except for the one-time payment

4. All payments shall be made by bank transfer to the account opened in the name of the LOCAL PARTNER, whose data can be found in Annex 1. This account shall be used exclusively for the present Project, and under no circumstances shall it be modified without the knowledge and prior acceptance by MANOS UNIDAS.

Three.- The LOCAL PARTNER hereby commits to carry out the implementation of the Project, ensuring that all aspects of the project comply with the Formulation approved by MANOS UNIDAS. The Local Partner declares that he/she knows and understands Manos Unidas' PLANNING TABLE and DETAILED BUDGET and the requirements included in the RULES FOR MONITORING PROJECTS FUNDED BY MANOS UNIDAS, which have also been sent to the Partner and shall be considered as an integral component of the present Agreement.

Four.- By means of this Agreement, the local partner hereby assumes the responsibility of meeting the following requirements:

- 1) Commence the implementation of the project not later than one month after receiving the first payment or the one-time payment. The date of receipt of this payment shall be considered the starting date of the LOCAL PARTNER's obligations contained in this Agreement, hereinafter "Start Date".
- 2) To complete the PROJECT within the stipulated time period (12 months) counting from the "Start Date".
- 3) Should circumstances make it impossible to comply with the original starting or finishing dates, the LOCAL PARTNER shall request a modification to MANOS UNIDAS. Manos Unidas shall study the reasons and approve the modification if so deemed necessary.
- 4) To present a detailed report of the progress of the PROJECT, according to the schedule below. Said report shall be drafted according to the guidelines included in the RULES FOR MONITORING PROJECTS FUNDED BY MANOS UNIDAS.

5) For both annual and multiannual Projects, the Narrative and Economic Reports shall be biannual, being this biannual period calculated from the "Start Date". 6) Where the Payment Plan exceeds the number of semesters envisaged and, consequently, a non-regular delivery of funds is required, this request shall be accompanied by the Follow-up Report and by the mandatory Justification.

7) Details of reports that the LOCAL PARTNER shall submit and dates in which those reports are due, are as follows.

1st Semester	7 months after the starting date
Completion	13 months after the starting date

MULTI-ANNUAL PROJECTS	
REPORT	DUE DATE
First Semester	7 months after the starting date
Second Semester	13 months after the starting date
Third Semester	19 months after the starting date
Fourth Semester and Final	25 months after the starting date

The sequence of reports will be the same for Projects over 2 years

8) To provide, when applicable, all additional information and documentation requested by Manos Unidas in an effort to better understand the PROJECT.

Five.- The LOCAL PARTNER hereby commits to reimburse the funds received and any interest accrued on said funds in the following cases:

5.1. In the event that MANOS UNIDAS verifies that the Project has not been carried out, after requesting the LOCAL PARTNER to fulfil its obligations.

5.2. If modifications over 10% are produced in any of the project's budgetary items; if there are changes in the schedule of activities, number of beneficiaries; or any other variation affecting the terms of the present agreement without obtaining prior authorization from MANOS UNIDAS.

5.3.If funds are applied to activities other than those contemplated in the Project.

5.4.If the local partner should fail to meet the stipulated obligations with regard to the submission of follow-up reports, both narrative and economic, according to the terms stipulated in the present agreement.

Six.- The local partner hereby commits to assign every asset acquired with the funds transferred by Manos Unidas to the project, according to the purposes for which they were acquired.

Seven.- Any modification of the terms and conditions of the present agreement must be approved in writing by both parties.

Eight.- The present agreement shall be effective from the date on which it is signed until such time when the local partner receives written notification of the finalisation of the Project from MANOS UNIDAS.

Nine. - In application of the Spanish regulations on the prevention of money laundering and terrorist financing, prior to the signing of this Agreement, the LOCAL PARTNER has confirmed to MANOS UNIDAS its formal and real identity.

Ten.- The LOCAL PARTNER, prior to the signing of this Agreement, has provided the documentation required by MANOS UNIDAS to assure the knowledge of its proper professional career and the honourability of the persons responsible for its management.

Eleven.- The LOCAL PARTNER must keep during 10 years the relevant documentation related to the Project financed by MANOS UNIDAS (Cooperation Agreement and original Invoices)

Twelve.- FCRA Registration Certificate and Early Termination Agreement. The LOCAL PARTNER, prior to signing this Agreement, must have provided MANOS UNIDAS with a copy of a valid FCRA Registration Certificate under its name and with expiry date at least 6 months after the project completion date as established in Four.- 2). In the event of cancellation, suspension, non-renewal or any other circumstances that render this FCRA Registration Certificate invalid during the duration of the present Agreement, this Collaboration Agreement will be terminated before its stipulated completion date.

Thirteen.- Data protection. MANOS UNIDAS, Campaign Against Hunger, NIF: G28567790, address: Barquillo, nº 38 - 28004 Madrid, (Spain), phone: (34) 91 700 38 77, e-mail: dpd@manosunidas.org, informs that the data provided in this agreement and those provided later within the framework of the implementation of the same, shall be processed with the purpose of implementing the Project under the present Agreement.

The legal basis for the data processing is the development of the agreement itself. The data will be retained as long as the project is implemented and during the legal periods that may be applicable. The information generated during the development of the project may be shared with third-party organisations and partners if the project so requires.

Relevant stakeholders can exercise their rights of access, rectification, deletion, restriction or objection by writing to MANOS UNIDAS, duly accrediting their identity. They also have the right to withdraw their consent and to lodge a complaint before the Supervisory Authority (Spanish Data Protection Agency www.agpd.es).

If data from third-party are provided, the applicant must previously obtain from them authorization for communicating those to MANOS UNIDAS and shall inform them about the aforementioned matter, to the extent that it does not involve a disproportionate effort.

Fourteen.- This Agreement shall be governed by Spanish law, and the Parties agree that the Spanish courts shall be competent in lodging legal actions that may be appropriate


